








Easter Children's Prayer

91 households were served

Four of those households are new guests to the WRFP

More than 2,022 pounds of non-perishable food was distributed

In addition to the non-perishable foods, Each household received two pounds of frozen meat

Each household received vouchers for milk, grapes, bananas and apples to be redeemed at Sharp Shopper

Each household received two dozen eggs

Each household received at least one loaf of bread

Each household received a 12 roll package of toilet tissue

February 22, 2024 distribution:

74 households were served

Two of those 74 households are new guests to the WRFP

Just less than 1500 pounds of non-perishable food was distributed

In addition to the non-perishable foods, each household had the choice of two pounds of hamburger, half a frozen ham or a frozen turkey breast.

Two pound packages of frozen venison were available in addition to the other frozen protein options

Each household received vouchers for milk, grapes, bananas and apples to be redeemed at Sharp Shopper

Each household received two dozen eggs

Each household received at least one loaf of bread

Each household received a 12 roll package of toilet tissue


